Evening Simon and Jacki,

The "Red Quarry Tiles" are made from clay (finest Etruria Marl). This is the same type of clay that was used by "Dennis of Ruabon", "Platts" and "Hawkins" when they were making quarry tiles in the UK for many years.

They are fired in gas fired kilns (in "sunny Wales"), fired so they are fully frost resistant and are of such a low water absorption that they do not require sealing.

They are tested for slip resistance and achieve 55 in the wet (so very low chance of slipping in wet conditions) but in areas where there is a high risk of surface contaminants we also offer R13 tiles with carborundum impregnated in the surface (usually required in kitchens etc.)
