## Application for consent to carry out work to protected trees

At: 1A Thorn Lane, Gledhow, Leeds

**For:** T1 - Beech tree - To draw back the branches of the beech tree from the house by 3-4m, crown lift lower branches by approximately 2 m, draw in branches on north side by 2m under the old pruning points and cut back overhanging branches. To keep tree under control as it is starting to dominate the front of the property.

We acknowledge receipt of your application to carry out work to protected trees received on 8 April 2024. Your proposal will be considered by officers in the Tree Team and they will aim to respond within eight weeks of 8 April 2024.

You do not have to appeal after this date as the Council will continue to consider your application and issue its decision as soon as possible and you may choose to wait. You should be aware that appealing will prevent the City Council from making a decision on your application and could lengthen the process considerably.

Once the Council has notified you of its decision, you can appeal against this if you are aggrieved by it or by any conditions attached to it.
