

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General Works

Removal of two yew trees that are dead / rotten.

We recently carried out work under 24/00190/WTPO. When tree surgeons visited they identified two additional yew trees that are mostly dead / rotten. These trees are largely bare or covered in ivy - rather than displaying good evergreen coverage as would be expected. We believe the trees are listed as T5 and T9.

More importantly, these two yew trees are positioned immediately inside our fence which runs alongside the A225 and we are keen to remove them to reduce any risk of injury to people and/or damage to cards property in the event they were to drop branches or fall during wind.
