The Forge is a Grade II listed thatched cottage, Circa C16, located in an elevated position adjacent to Shute Road close to the gatehouse of Shute House. It is set in approximately 1.5 acres of meadow and gardens on the north east side of the road, surrounded by other dwellings and grazing pastures.

The property is a thatched, white wash stone rubble two storey cottage with a mix of wooden windows and doors of various ages with attached single story tiled stone rubble storage barn. In 2012 following planning and listed building consent (ref 12/0813/LBC & 12/0812/FUL) the storage barn was converted to provide an annexe and holiday accommodation.

- Erection of a 5.0m x 3.6m timber built garden studio / summer house with decking. Traditional design pitched roof building with walls and roof finished in black painted galvanised steel corrugated profile. Simple sliding double glazed doors and windows to south and east elevations. Decking area to south and east sides of building. Mounted on ground screws and timber supports.
- 2. Erection of a 3.6m x 2.4m traditional greenhouse. Mounted on rolled stone or scalping base.

# Statement of Significance for The Forge, Shute, Axminster, Devon EX13 7PU

The Forge is a Grade II listed thatched cottage, Circa C16, located in an elevated position adjacent to Shute Road close to the gatehouse of Shute House. It is set in approximately 1.5 acres of meadow and gardens on the north east side of the road, surrounded by other dwellings and grazing pastures.

Important characteristics of the cottage as set out in the 1981 listing include:

- 1. Thatched roof with gabled ends.
- 2. Three window range. C19/20 casements.
- 3. Round-arched plank door off centre in heavy round-arched chamfered timber doorframe.
- 4. Similar doorframe on opposite end of cross passage (rear).
- 5. Brick ridge chimney stacks.
- 6. Two pairs of jointed cruck trusses.
- 7. Stop chamfered ceiling beams and fireplace bressumer.
- 8. Including implement shed adjoining south east; single storey tiled roof.

The cottage is not in a conservation area but it is situated in the East Devon AONB.
