

Heritage Statement

1. 5216 PARK LANE The Greyhound Public TL 41 SE 2/11 House GV II 2. Circa 1700 range with one storey and attics, timber framed and weatherboarded, partially obscured by Victorian ground storey addition. Roof peg-tiled with ridge, gables and 3 hipped dormers and a 'bottle' chimney stack near centre. Later stack flanks east end. Dormers have small-paned casements, 3 casements in a set at ground storey west, then stock brick Victorian extension, flat roofed, and with fluted red brick pilasters, 2 doors and 4 fixed and mullioned windows between them above a panelled brick stall-riser.

Whilst designing our proposed signage scheme, we were keenly aware of the history of this site and its prominence within the wider street scene. As a result, we opted to design a like for like scheme in terms of signage locations, with a lighter redecoration colour to enhance the appearance of the site.

We have tried to replicate the existing sign sizes where possible as the existing signs are scaled perfectly for the building to accommodate, without them becoming overbearing.

Where we have positioned the lighting will allow the key architectural features of the building to be highlighted without dominating the street scene.

Overall, we feel that our proposed scheme is sympathetic and will enhance/protect the building for many years to come.
