
## Drawing Notes from Landscape Consultancy LIS/B

'All the soft landscape proposals will take account of the existing structure, pattern, composition and character of the landscape local to the site through the use of complementary planting."

'All landscape works will be carried out broadly in accordance with the relevant current British Standards'

'The landscape scheme is confirmed as being timetabled for implementation by or during the first planting season (mid-November to mid-March) after substantial completion of the development, or (where applicable) prior to sale of any individual plot(s), whichever is the sooner.'

'Any dead, dying or failing plants will be replaced like for like during the next planting season.'
