Access Statement for 79 High Street, Bexley, Kent, DA5 1JX

For directions and details of how to reach us please enter your postcode on Google Maps and when prompted our postcode DA5 1JX.

The nearest railway station is Bexley which is 200m away. Taxis are available at the station. If you require an accessible taxi this can be booked in advance, see contact information for details.

The nearest bus stop is 100m from the premises – ask the driver to stop on Bourne Road/High Street. There is a shelter with seating on Bourne Road. All busses can accommodate one wheelchair.

There are zebra crossings located throughout the village on Bourne Road and the High Street.

Car Parking Facilities and Arrival

There is a pay and display public car park 100m from the shop just of the High Street. There are many parking spaces, and ample clearly marked Blue Badge parking spaces.

We can assist should you need any help to enter the property.

Ground and First Floor

Lighting throughout is natural daylight, overhead and wall lighting.

Toilets

Toilets, including a unisex accessible toilet can be found to the rear of the property. There is a small step down 45mm to the toilet.

The entrance to the toilet is 740mm wide and level entry into the toilet.

The toilet height is 400mm.

The toilet is well lit, with fluorescent overhead lighting and pull cord to switch the lights on, and emergency red cord should you require assistance.

Non slip laminate flooring.

Lever mixer tap on the sink.

Good colour contrast between critical surfaces, walls are magnolia, surrounds dark brown wood and toilet and washbasin are white.

First Floor

We have a first floor area, access is via stairs with a banister for support. There are 13 steps. This can be accessed via the main lobby to the stairs.

Additional Information

We have a set of evacuation procedures; accessibility is taken into account as part of our fire assessment. Should you require assistance someone will come to your table and help you with evacuation either out of the building or to a refuge.

Clear signage is used throughout the premises using Arial font and large black letters on a yellow background.

We have an area where a mobility scooter can be charged.
