SD2 -Locations considered within the park for the location of the skatepark

Area is close proximity to the backs of the houses would have same issue as current skatepark with noises/smells, closer to the school however still visible from the road so safer.

Proposed Location

Visible from the road for natural surveillance, will deter ASB issues, closer to play area for parents to keep an eye on their kids in skatepark and play area at the same time, less intimidating for females and young skaters it's an open, busy area not secluded

Area is too near the school, very close to the houses.

School Use Gated green space for the school to use for sports days or pe session, cannot consider this space for the skatepark

Existing skatepark Next to school playground, noises heard and smells drift into the playground, no lighting or natural surveillance, very close to the houses, .dark area that cannot be seen, unsafe for skaters especially young and female skaters.

Too close proximity to the back of the houses, no lighting, same issues as the existing skatepark, just a little further from the school but closer to the back of houses.

<u>Jackson lane car park</u> for use when visiting the park

Close proximity to the flats backing onto the park noise would be heard in flats, smaller area space, West Villa is not as busy a road for natural surveillance as Westfield Road

Event Space This space is used for events e.g. the funfair which comes 2-3 times as year this area,there is hardstanding which reduces the grass area being ruined with vehicles bringing in equipment.
