As a homeowner in Wellingborough and a 20 yr old Design engineer, father to a 10 & 12 yr old. We have enjoyed using local skateparks in Northamptonshire but always have to travel to either Kettering, Irthlingborough, Thrapston or Northampton due to bassets park not being fit for purpose.

If you use Iselodge skatepark in Kettering as an example you can sit and watch the park and you will witness individuals, families or groups of ages ranging from 3yrs through to 60+yrs all enjoying a sporting activity together. These skate parks are the breeding grounds for future Olympic stars or kids that just want to express themselves..

The town should also have a more dedicated cycling activities such as pump tracks or Bmx racing (Wellingborough Wildcats). Stanton cross should also be considered to have similar instead of an activity area that only suits toddlers.
