Two dead lime trees in the rear garden of 9 Haywood Park, Stewkley. The dead trees require total removal as they could do considerable damage to neighbouring property, they are unsafe and pose imminent danger. I have been in correspondence with Neil Pasmore, Arboricultural Inspector, Buckinghamshire Council, who has confirmed permission will be given to remove the trees, subject to the replacement of two broadleaf trees, not Lime trees.

Thank you for your application which was registered on the 18th April 2024. The application is being dealt with.

There is no fee necessary for this application.

If I have not sent you a decision by 13th June 2024 and you have not agreed to extend the period for the Council to make a decision, you then have a period of 28 days in which you can lodge an appeal with the Secretary of State for the Environment on a form available from the Department of the Environment, Eastern Regional Office (Environment), Heron House, 49-51 Goldington Road, Bedford, MK40 3LL. You will appreciate that it is not always possible for an application to be dealt with within the period given, and you may wish to contact this office before proceeding further with an appeal as once an appeal is lodged, a decision on the application cannot be made by the Council.
