A proposal simply to `cut back' or `lop' a tree is too vague, because it fails to identify the extent of the works. Instead, try to use descriptions such as crown thinning, crown reduction or crown lifting, and specify how much pruning you have in mind, e.g. crown thinning by 15 per cent.
