A bat survey will be required before your application can be validated. This must meet the 'Minimum Standards for Bat Surveys in West Yorkshire'

(https://www.wyjs.org.uk/media/1367/150603-minimum-standards-for-bat-surveys-version-5-draft-lp.pdf) and other current best practice guidance and be undertaken by a licensed bat worker. These guidelines normally require dawn or dusk surveys to be undertaken between May and September. However, where a winter survey establishes that there is limited bat roost potential or that adverse impacts can be avoided, a dawn or dusk survey may not be required.
