
Dear Sam

I have recently made an initial assessment for a dropped kerb at this address and noted that the verge is not Highway, maintained at public expense. Therefore, you will first need to obtain an Easement Agreement with the landowner before we can install a dropped kerb and drive.

The current cost would be approximately £3500 to install the dropped kerb and provide a driveway, up to the boundary of the property. The width would be 2.7M.
