Shop, offices and entrance to shopping mall. Late C18/early C19 with C20 alterations. Coursed squared limestone rubble with ashlar dressings to front, cement render to rear, rear wing coursed limestone rubble; welsh slate hipped parapeted roof, artificial slate to rear slope and hipped roof to rear wing; main range has 2 brick right-end stacks. 3-storey 3-window range. First floor has three 6/6-pane sashes in cement-rendered surrounds with stone cills; second floor has three similar 3/6-pane sashes in similar surrounds; ground floor has C20 plate glass shop window and glazed door to right, former carriage entrance with elliptical arched opening to left now forms entrance to shopping mall, blocked former doorway to far left. Band course over ground floor; cill band to second floor. Rear elevation has C20 top-hung lights to first and second floor. Rear wing has to left side two segmental arched openings to first floor, one with C19 three-light timber casement, one blocked, to ground floor two C20 shop windows and two half-glazed doors. Rear elevation of wing has C20 windows to ground and first floors, to first floor in broad segmental arched opening. INTERIOR not inspected, noted as having undergone C20 alterations. Openings to first floor suggest possible former workshop use.
