I acknowledge receipt of your application for Listed Building Consent dated 5th March 2024. However, I regret I cannot accept your application as valid for the following reasons:-

- 1. Please provide a 1:20 detail of the proposed internal doors to the new store area. This should include details of the material and colour finish as well as any proposed door surround detail and supporting brochures for the proposed ironmongery.
- 2. Please provide existing internal elevations to compare against the proposed elevations as submitted. For clarity this is to understand the differences between the old and new radiators and given that the radiator detail is not to scale.
- 3. The Land Ownership Certificate submitted with the original application will become out of date from 26th March 2023 and will be dated more than 21 days from the date of original certification. To ensure the application is legislatively correct, please provide in addition to any additional information submitted after this date, confirmation that the details of land ownership have not changed since the original Certificate was signed and dated.

Alternatively, please provide an updated Land Ownership Certificate. Forms can be downloaded online by selecting the Paper forms link and is contained within the application forms package at https://www.eplanning.scot/
