Installation of a 22.5m lattice tower with 3no. antennas, 4no. transmission dishes and ancillary development in a compound surrounded by a deer fence enclosure and gabion walls. The proposed compound will accommodate 10No cabinets, 1No meter cabinet, 1No off grid power generator, fuel tank and ancillary development. Installation of 2No 15m high wind turbines and 36No solar panels within a compound to the South, accessed via a proposed 150m long ATV track from the existing public road.
