If the Council does not object to the proposed work, it will aim to notify you in writing on or within six weeks of 23 April 2024. After this period of time, if you have not received a written response, you are entitled to proceed with the work.

Please note that this does not apply to trees which are protected by a Tree Preservation Order, for which written consent must be obtained before any work can proceed.

If the Council objects to the proposed work and if the tree is (or trees are) considered to be important to the visual amenity of the area, a Tree Preservation Order may be made to protect the tree(s).
