Medusa Design Ltd have been appointed by the client to submit an application for the re-roof of Red House and Cocoa Nut House, Hall Street, Long Melford, Suffolk.

The design access & heritage proposals have been produced to meet the client's requirements, following an in-depth study of the site and its surroundings.

The statement provides a summary of the considerations taken into account in the design and access of the development and its site.

1. Site

The application site comprises terraced properties situated on the west side of Hall Street, Long Melford, opposite the Bull Hotel. Red House and Cocoa-nut House are brick built, two storey, properties under a plain tiled roof. The windows and doors are all timber framed painted in off white.

The properties have a small rear garden and shared courtyard with access from Hall Street between Red House and Bassett's House.

Red House and Cocoa-nut House are Grade 2 Listed (List entry number 1183020). They were first listed on February 9th 1978.
