Planning Context

Site Appraisal & Historical Context

The Ship Inn is a public house situated on the harbourside of Mousehole, a coastal village to the south of the main Town of Penzance.

2 storeys with stone external walls under a slate roof. The site is Grade II Listed as part of a grouping with the attached building (11 South Cliff)

2. C18. heightened C19. Whitewashed rubble, tarred plinth. Slurried big slate roof, wide eaves. 2 storeys. 4 windows, one blocked. Sashes without glazing bars. One oriel bay on 1st floor. Plain recessed door under bay window. Right hand part early C19 whitened stucco, 2 storeys, 4 windows, sashes without glazing bars, slate roof. Included for group value.

Proposed Works

It is proposed to remove the existing brick fireplace recess surround, wooden mantel and brick edge hearth, enlarge the existing recess and install a new woodburning stove, rebuild the surround re-using the salvaged bricks or reclaimed bricks matching existing, new slate hearth and oak mantel.

The works will also involve the lining of the existing failed liner.

Impact on the Asset - Justification

The current open fire is unusable due to the existing flue collapsing, the space available to re-line would be too small for an open fire. The collapsed flue can be relined with a smaller diameter liner suitable for stoves only.
