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1. SCOPE

- 1.1 Hillside Trees Ltd has been engaged by Paul Nilski to assess 7 No. trees growing on land to the rear of 28 Southfield Road, Cotham, Bristol, BS6 6AY
- 1.2 The purpose is to assess the condition of the trees and make appropriate recommendations for management.
- 1.3 This is a preliminary report based on a tree survey undertaken by a consultant experienced in arboriculture.
- 1.4 The survey was undertaken on 15th April 2024

3.0 LEGAL

- 3.1 T1 (Sycamore) is subject to Bristol City Council Tree Preservation Order No.1450. An application must be made to the Council for the recommended work.
- 3.2 T3, T4, T5, T6 & T7 are located in the Cotham and Redland Conservation Area. Six weeks' notice of the recommended works must be given to the Council.
- 3.3 It is an offence under the Wildlife and Countryside Act and Countryside and Rights of Way Act to disturb a nesting bird. Work to trees/shrubs with the potential for nesting birds, which also (with few exceptions) enjoy statutory protection, should be carried out between the end of August and the end of February. Further advice may be obtained from Natural England.
