Steps from the kitchen 2. Large patio steps from dining room and 3. large broad steps from French doors. All are at the same height and the patio has been in place since I moved in in October 1993. Plan is to replace and integrate all 3 structures at existing height with decking and a balustrade. Also plan to replace existing fence between my property and number 14 Menock Road with as high a fence as is allowed - hopefully at least 2.4 meters. You cannot exit the house unless the decking is at this height. Two of three sides of garden are totally secluded and the third side has a fence (6ft) between me and number 14. No neighbouring garden was going to be more overlooked than before.
