Reason for Work:

Both groups have clear visual signs of Ash Dieback mostly stage 2, some stage 3 and a few stage 4 with drawn up attenuated trunks and stems. The proposal is to fell the 'red cross' marked trees and reduce the remaining group concentrated on the lower right hand side of the rear garden by 50% retaining Ivy and understory Hawthorne for habitat etc.
