Listed Building Consent for Internal Alterations at 55 Low Street, Banff, Aberdeenshire, AB45 1AU

I refer to your application for the above. Under the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) (Scotland) Act 1997 there is a legal requirement for the public display of the attached notice for a period of not less than 7 days. The notice must have been on public display for a minimum of 7 days prior to the expiry date for public comment, 6 June 2024

The notice should be displayed in a prominent position at or near the site, e.g where it is an alteration to an existing building, on a gate or a storm water downpipe, or, if the development has yet to commence, a fence post, tree or similar.
