Hi there,

I am writing to apply to carry out tree works under a five day notice.

The tree is an ornamental cherry and is situated at 15 Royal Park, Clifton, Bristol BS8 3AL

The tree was impacted by a delivery lorry which caused substantial cracking to a major limb. This limb is now hanging over the pavement and road and is in an unstable condition. Please see photos attached.

The proposed works are to remove the damaged limb back to the nearest union and remove other small broken branches resulting from the same incident.

Given that the tree is not being removed, I am assuming that there will be no need to replant. Also please note that this tree is not dying but is dangerous, hence my application through this channel rather than the standard planning portal route.
