Description Of Proposed Development : Replacement of existing windows with steel heritage double glazing, replacement of two wooden window sub-frames with hard wood sub-frames and loss of a number of wooden sub-frames so that the steel windows fix directly into the stone casement

Location: Greens Cottage Great Rissington Cheltenham Gloucestershire

The above application was received by Cotswold District Council on 18 April 2024 and was not accompanied by an Environmental Impact Assessment with a formal Environmental Statement.

The development falls under Schedule 2 of the above regulations and is within a "sensitive area" because it falls within an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty as defined in Regulation 2, subparagraph (1) Interpretation. Having considered the criteria stated within Schedule 3 the Local Planning Authority concludes that it will have no significant environmental effects having regard to its nature, size and location and therefore **will not** require the submission of an Environmental Impact Assessment.
