Condition 3 - Material samples and details

Bricks – Imperial handmade clay brick spec code 107 – photo attached

Roof Tiles – Hanbury Burmarsh handmade clay tiles photo attached

Condition 4 – Brick bond style and mortar pointing – running stretcher bond with pointing tamped with a stiff brush back 2mm from brick face as sample panel above. Mortar mix 1 part white cement, 2 part Wareham sand, 1 part sharp sand to obtain a cream colour rather than grey/green.
